Facts stated herein are as known to the State of California, Caltrans, and are to be  
verified by the Contractor as per Section 2 “Bidding” of the 2010 Standard  
Specifications. All work at optional sites is at Contractor’s expense.

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## **General Information**

These sites are provided by Caltrans, at the option of the contractor, as disposal sites for the Flume Creek Major Maintenance Project.

These sites must be included in the contractor's Storm Water Pollution Control Plan and all Construction Storm Water Best Management Practices shall apply to this site. No additional compensation shall be made for placement of the erosion control measures at these disposal sites.

These sites have been environmentally approved for this project, however, they are not warranted to be completely satisfactory to the contractor's needs.

The State assumes no liability for damage to Contractor's equipment. No compensation will be made to the contractor for the handling of non-hazardous man-made objects.

Existing facilities at these disposal sites shall be protected from damage by the contractor in accordance with Section 5-1.36 "Property and Facility Preservation" of the Standard Specifications.


Materials are to be placed within the site limits in an organized and safe manner, with no risk of instability to embankments or drainage facilities.

All asphalt grindings generated by this project not placed in a disposal site identified by Caltrans will remain property of the contractor.

If the contractor uses a disposal location other than those shown in this Materials Information Handout attention is directed to Section 5-1.20B(4) of the Standard Specifications.

The contractor bears all liability for damage to haul vehicles and any facility or equipment damaged by the contractor's use of the site. The State assumes no liability for damage to contractor's equipment.

## Optional Site 1: SHA-5-4.5(NB)




Provisions that apply to this site:

The disposal site is located on Interstate 5 at post mile 4.5 (NB) in Siskiyou County, is provided by Caltrans as an optional location for temporary stockpiling of asphalt grindings. In addition to temporary storage, up to 2,000 cubic yards of asphalt grindings may be permanently disposed by the contractor at this site. If disposal occurs the material will become property of the State.

The site, located just south of the Mott Rd. interchange (Exit #734), is used by Caltrans Maintenance and other contractors for various purposes, without exclusive use to anyone. The contractor shall contact Caltrans Maintenance Supervisor Jerry Brown at least 48 hours prior to the beginning of work at phone number (530) 235-2839 for site coordination. No other materials shall be accepted at this site without the Maintenance Supervisor's prior approval. Road access, stockpile location, as well as any site requirements shall be directed by Field Maintenance.

## Optional Site 2: SHA-5-63.5(SB)




Provisions that apply to this site:

The disposal site, located approximately 3.2 miles west of Interstate 5 off Castle Creek Road in Shasta County, is a narrow, two-lane, un-striped, paved road. The Castella/Castle Crags Interchange (#724) is within the project post mile limits. This site is provided by the US Forest Service only for the permanent disposal of asphalt grindings. Temporary stockpiles will not be allowed and all grindings deposited at this location will become property of the Forest Service.

The contractor shall contact Forest Service Engineer Ken Kellogg at least 1 week prior to the beginning of disposal for site coordination at: (530) 926-9625. Vehicle access and parking for the Dog Creek Trail must be maintained during disposal operations and after disposal is complete. No other materials shall be accepted at this site.

### Optional Site 3: SIS-5-8.71(NB)



Provisions that apply to this site:

The disposal site is located approximately 1/2 mile north of Interstate 5 at the south end of Mt. Shasta Blvd in Siskiyou County. It is accessed from the Mt. Shasta City Exit (#737) which is located six miles north of the project post mile limits. The site is provided by the City of Mt. Shasta only for the permanent disposal of up to 5,000 cubic yards of asphalt grindings. Temporary stockpiles will not be allowed and any grindings deposited at this location will become property of the City of Mt. Shasta.

The contractor shall contact the Public Works Director Rod Bryan at least 1 week prior to the beginning of disposal for site coordination at: (530) 926-7526. No other materials shall be accepted at this site.
