Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in PLACER COUNTY NEAR LINCOLN FROM 0.6 KM NORTH OF TWELVE BRIDGES OVERCROSSING TO 1.3 KM SOUTH OF BEAR RIVER.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on May 21, 2008.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions, the Proposal and Contract, and replace the copy of the Information Handout.

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.18, "PROJECT INFORMATION," under "INFORMATION AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION AT THE NORTH REGION CONSTRUCTION OFFICE IS AS FOLLOWS" paragraph, the following items are added:

- "M. County of Placer Encroachment Permit Issued to the City of Lincoln
- N. City of Lincoln Grading Permit
- O. Haul Road Existing Conditions Surveys and Exhibits"

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.26, "RELATIONS WITH PLACER COUNTY," and Section 5-1.27, "RELATIONS WITH THE CITY OF LINCOLN," are added as attached.

5-1.26 RELATIONS WITH PLACER COUNTY

The retention basin included in this project is located within the jurisdiction of the Placer County. The City of Lincoln on behalf of the Department has obtained an encroachment permit for the retention basin from Placer County. Adherence to the conditions of the permit shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. The Contractor shall be fully informed of the requirements of this encroachment permit as well as rules, regulations, and conditions that may govern the Contractor's operations in these areas and shall conduct the work accordingly.

Copies of the encroachment permit may be obtained as provided in "Project Information" of these special provisions. For information regarding obtaining encroachment permits from Placer County to use county roads to haul material, the Contractor shall contact County of Placer Department of Public Works at, 3091 County Center Drive, Suite 220, Auburn, CA 95603, Telephone (530) 745-7546.

Attention is directed to Section 7, "Legal Relations and Responsibility," of the Standard Specifications.

Many bridges in Placer County are subject to bridge postings limiting the weight of vehicles allowed across. Some of these bridges are not sufficient to take continuous heavy loads and are subject to reduced load limitations or closures during the life of this contract. The bridges include but are not limited to the following locations:

1. Moore Road at Canal Road
2. Dowd Rd at Markham Ravine
3. North Dowd Rd at Airport Slough
4. North Dowd Rd at Coon Creek
5. Nelson Rd at Markham Ravine
6. Nelson Rd at Auburn Ravine
7. Nelson Rd at Auburn Ravine
8. Moore Rd at Auburn Ravine

The Contractor shall bear all responsibility and any associated costs that may result as a change to the conditions of the County's roads or bridges.

5-1.27 RELATIONS WITH THE CITY OF LINCOLN

The Department has obtained a grading permit for the retention basin from the City of Lincoln. Adherence to the conditions of the permit shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. The Contractor shall be fully informed of the requirements of this grading permit as well as rules, regulations, and conditions that may govern the Contractor's operations in these areas and shall conduct the work accordingly.
