Addendum No. 5

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN SONOMA COUNTY IN AND NEAR COTATI AND ROHNERT PARK FROM 2.8 KM SOUTH OF RAILROAD AVENUE UNDERCROSSING TO ROHNERT PARK EXPRESSWAY OVERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Wednesday, October 14, 2009.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions, and provide an additional Information Handout.

In the Special Provisions, Section 4., "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," the following paragraph is added as the last paragraph.

"A draft Conceptual Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) has been prepared for this Contract as described in "Supplemental Project Information," of these special provisions. The Contractor shall adhere to the draft Conceptual SWPPP for all construction activities planned for the first 70 days after contract approval, or until the Contractor's SWPPP as required in "Water Pollution Control," of these special provisions is approved by the Engineer. The Contractor shall sign the "Initial SWPPP Certification," included within the draft Conceptual SWPPP and submit it to the Engineer before commencing any construction activity. The Contractor's SWPPP shall supersede the draft Conceptual SWPPP upon Engineer's approval."

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.07, "SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION," in the second paragraph, Item 14 is added as follows:

"14. Draft Conceptual Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.03, "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL," subsection "GENERAL," the following paragraph is added after the second paragraph:

"A draft Conceptual Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan has been prepared for this contract and is available as described in "Supplemental Project Information" of these special provisions."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.03, "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL," subsection "STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN," the sixth paragraph is revised as follows:

"Within 10 days after contract approval, follow this process for SWPPP approval:

1. Submit 3 copies of the SWPPP and allow 15 days for the Engineer's review. If revisions are required, the Engineer provides comments and specifies the date that the review stopped.
2. Revise and resubmit the SWPPP within 5 days of receipt of the Engineer's comments. The Engineer's review resumes when the complete SWPPP is resubmitted. Allow 5 days for the Engineer's second review.
3. If additional comments are provided by the Engineer, the SWPPP shall be revised and resubmitted within 5 days of the Engineer's second review.
4. When the Engineer accepts the SWPPP as complete, the Engineer will submit the SWPPP to the San Francisco Bay RWQCB for their review and approval.
5. If the San Francisco Bay RWQCB provides comments to the SWPPP, the contractor shall incorporate these comments within 5 days of receipt. The contractor shall submit four (4) copies of the final SWPPP upon notification of final approval.
6. Construction activities shall begin no sooner than 30 days after the Engineer approves the SWPPP.
7. After the 30 days, the Engineer may conditionally approve the SWPPP while minor revisions are being completed.

If the Engineer fails to complete the review within the time allowed and if, in the opinion of the Engineer, completion of the work is delayed or interfered with because of the Engineer's or the RWQCB's review, the Department pays you for resulting losses, and grants an extension of time."

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To Bid book holders:

Attached is a copy of the Information Handout titled, "Draft Conceptual Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan".
Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the Notice to Bidders section of the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the Bid book.

Submit bids in the Bid book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
