14-6.02C(5) Protection Measures

Within species protection area 1 (SPA 1), implement the following protection measures:

1. Notify the Engineer 30 days before initiating any ground-disturbing activities, including, but not limited to trimming, clearing, or grubbing of vegetation and any other construction-related activities. The Department-approved biologist will perform surveys. Do not begin construction activities until authorized by the Engineer.
2. All jobsite workers must attend a Department-provided 2-hour "Worker Environmental Awareness" training. Training will be held at the Engineer's field office. Notify the Engineer 30 days before starting construction to schedule training.

Within species protection area 2 (SPA 2), implement the following protection measures:

1. Work within SPA 2 may occur only during the dry season (June 15 through October 15) to avoid wetlands, waters, and special status species.
2. Notify the Engineer at least 5 business days before any ground-disturbing activities, including, but not limited to trimming, clearing, or grubbing of vegetation and any other construction-related activities at any SPA 2 locations. The Department will perform preconstruction surveys for species and/or biological monitoring. Do not begin construction activities until authorized.
