Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in ALAMEDA COUNTY IN AND NEAR LIVERMORE AND PLEASANTON FROM 4.3 KM EAST OF ROUTE 84/680 SEPARATION TO RUBY HILLS DRIVE.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on December 13, 2006.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions and to revise the Federal Minimum Wages with Modification 46 dated 12-1-06.

In the Special Provisions, Section 5-1.17, "PROJECT INFORMATION," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"Information available for inspection at the District Office is as follows:

- A. Cross sections
- B. Dewatering and Non-Stormwater Information Handout
- C. United States Army Corp of Engineers Permit
- D. 1602 Fish and Game Notification
- E. U.S. Fish and Wildlife Biological Opinion
- F. Geotechnical Design Report"

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.02, "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL," subsection, "STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN PREPARATION, APPROVAL AND AMENDMENTS" the seventh paragraph is revised as follows:

"The following contract items of work shall be incorporated into the SWPPP as "Temporary Water Pollution Control Practices": Temporary Concrete Washout Facility, Dewatering and Non Stormwater Discharge Control, Temporary Construction Entrance, Temporary Silt Fence, , Temporary Drainage Inlet Protection, Temporary Check Dam, Move-in/Move-out (Hydraulic Mulch –Temporary Bonded Fiber Matrix). The Contractor's attention is directed to the special provisions provided for Temporary Water Pollution Control Practices, and to the Stormwater and Non-Stormwater Information Handout that is available at the Department of Transportation, Duty Senior Desk, 111 Grand Avenue, Oakland, CA 94623, e-mail:duty-senior@dot.ca.gov, telephone (510)286-5209."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.02, "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL," subsection, "STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN PREPARATION, APPROVAL AND AMENDMENTS" the second sentence in the thirteenth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Engineer will have 40 working days to review the SWPPP."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "DEWATERING AND NON-STORM DISCHARGE CONTROL," the sixth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Contractor's attention is directed to the Stormwater and Non-storm Water Information Handout that is available at the Department of Transportation, Duty Senior Desk, 111 Grand Avenue, Oakland, CA 94623, e-mail: dutyseior@dot.ca.gov, telephone (510) 286-5209. The Stormwater and Non-storm Water Information Handout includes a sample Daily Inspection Report (DIR) described elsewhere in this special provision, and Off-site Disposal Facility information for dewatering discharges."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "DEWATERING AND NON-STORM DISCHARGE CONTROL," the following paragraphs are added after the sixth paragraph:

Attention is directed to "Water Pollution Control" of these special provisions regarding the requirements for implementing temporary water pollution control practices.

Attention is directed to "Relations with California Regional Water Quality Control Board" regarding the Order No. R2-2006-0033 issued for covering work to be performed under this contract."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "DEWATERING AND NON-STORM DISCHARGE CONTROL," subsection, "DISPOSAL," the third sentence in the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"Attention is directed to the Stormwater and Non-storm Water Information Handout for information on off-site facilities."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "DEWATERING AND NON-STORM DISCHARGE CONTROL," subsection, "WATER QUALITY REQUIREMENTS", is revised as follows:

"Water Quality Requirements include all discharge prohibitions and receiving water limitations included in Order R2-2006-0033 referenced within "Relations with California Regional Water Quality Control Board" of these special provisions, but not limited to the following limitations listed in this section. A copy of this Order is available as part of the Information Handout as described within "Project Information" of these special provisions.

Constituent	<u>Receiving Water Limitations</u>
Turbidity	Downstream turbidity < 50 NTU (when, Natural Background Turbidity < 50NTU), or Downstream turbidity < 10% above natural background turbidity, when it is > 50NTU
PH	The pH shall not be depressed below 6.5 nor raised above 8.5, nor caused to vary from normal ambient pH by more than 0.5 pH units.
Dissolved Oxygen (DO)	5.0 mg/L, minimum; The median dissolved oxygen concentration for any three consecutive months shall not be less than 80% of the dissolved oxygen content at saturation. When natural factors cause concentrations less than that specified above, then the discharges shall not cause further reduction in ambient dissolved oxygen concentrations.
Nutrients:	Waters shall not contain biostimulatory substances in concentrations that promote aquatic growths to the extent that such growths cause nuisance or adversely affect beneficial uses.

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Downstream measurements shall be taken at 30 m downstream of the discharge point within 0.30 meter of water surface.

Natural Background measurements shall be taken at 30 m upstream of discharge point within 0.30 meter of water surface."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "DEWATERING AND NON-STORM DISCHARGE CONTROL," subsection, "DEWATERING AND DISCHARGE PLAN," the second sentence in the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Contractor shall allow 20 working days for the Engineer to review and approve the DDP."

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
