Within the project limits, implement the following protection measures from February 15 to September 1:

1. Initial bird survey and work authorization period:
 - 1.1. Notify the Engineer 10 days before the start of pruning, vegetation removal, or ground disturbing work. A Department Biologist will perform an initial survey of the job site or work area.
 - 1.2. Proceed with the initial pruning, vegetation removal or ground work when authorized.
 - 1.3. This work authorization is valid for 72 hours.
2. Subsequent bird surveys and work authorization periods:
 - 2.1. Notify the Engineer 7 days before pruning, vegetation removal, or ground disturbing work. A Department Biologist will perform a survey of the job site or work area.
 - 2.2. Proceed with the pruning, vegetation removal or ground work when authorized.
 - 2.3. This work authorization is valid for 72 hours.
