Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for CONSTRUCTION ON STATE HIGHWAY IN FRESNO COUNTY NEAR KETTLEMAN CITY AT THE COALINGA-AVENAL SAFETY ROADSIDE REST AREA.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on Tuesday, July 28, 2009.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Project Plans, the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions, and the Federal Minimum Wages with Modification Number 32 dated 07/10/2009.

On Project Plan Sheet 5 the existing northbound comfort station existing final finished elevation (FFE) is 533.38.

On Project Plan Sheet 7 the existing southbound comfort station existing final finished elevation (FFE) is 545.73.

On Project Plan Sheet 132, on Detail 1, "Rigid Frame Footing Detail", the note "Conc Slab, for Reinf see" is revised to "Concrete Slab, for Reinf see Sheet ST-2, note A".

In the Notice to Bidders, the Contractor license is revised as follows:

"At the time this contract is awarded, the Contractor must possess either a Class A license or Class B license or any combination of Class C licenses which constitutes a majority of the work."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.39, "MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION," the fourteenth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The contract price paid per square foot for minor concrete (exposed aggregate sidewalk) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials (including welded wire fabric, where required, and all the work involved to prepare and present samples of colored concrete) tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in constructing minor concrete (exposed aggregate sidewalk) paving, including providing initial samples complete in place, as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.39, "MISCELLANEOUS CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION," the twenty-eighth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The contract price paid per square foot for minor concrete (textured paving) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials (including welded wire fabric, where required), tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in constructing textured paving, including grouted areas, complete in place, as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 12-3.01. "CAST-IN-PLACE CONCRETE," subsection "PART 3 - EXECUTION", subheading "PREPARATION," the sixth paragraph "Hydronic Tubing" is deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 12-3.01. "CAST-IN-PLACE CONCRETE," subsection "PART 3 - EXECUTION", subheading "PLACING CONCRETE," the sixth paragraph is deleted.

To Bid book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the Notice to Bidders section of the Notice to Bidders and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the Bid book.

Submit bids in the Bid book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.

This office is sending this addendum by confirmed facsimile to all book holders to ensure that each receives it. A copy of this addendum and the modified wage rates are available for the Contractors' use on the Web site:
