Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in KERN COUNTY IN BAKERSFIELD FROM 0.1 KM EAST OF ROUTE 58/99 SEPARATION TO 0.1 KM EAST OF SOUTH CHESTER AVENUE OVERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on January 10, 2007.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Project Plans, and the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Project Plan Sheet 26 is revised as follows:

In the "Plant List and Planting Specifications" table, under the "Commercial Fertilizer" column, under the column "PLT ESTB" in row 1 for "Plant Group H," the quantity of "39 g/m²" is deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "Beginning of Work, Time of Completion and Liquidated Damages," the fourth, fifth and eighth paragraphs are deleted, and the sixth and seventh paragraphs are revised as follows:

"The Contractor shall diligently prosecute all work (including plant establishment) to completion before the expiration of **80 WORKING DAYS** beginning on the fifteenth calendar day after approval of the contract."

"The Contractor shall pay to the State of California the sum of \$6,400 per day, for each and every calendar day's delay in completing the work in excess of **80 WORKING DAYS**."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-2.01, "General," in subsection "Cost Break-Down," in the "Highway Planting Cost Break-Down" table, the quantity for "Commercial Fertilizer (Slow Release)" is revised to 28g.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-2.03, "Existing Highway Irrigation Facilities," the first paragraph of subsection "Plant Establishment Work," is revised as follows:

"The plant establishment period shall be Type 2 and shall not be less than 20 working days."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-2.03, "Existing Highway Irrigation Facilities," in subsection "Plant Establishment Work," the third and eighth paragraphs are deleted.

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To Proposal and Contract book holders:
