SECTION 4. BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Within 10 days after contract approval, submit a request for authorization to begin work at the job site. The request must include:

1. Baseline Progress Schedule (Critical Path Method)
2. Date you plan to begin work

The Department does not allow modifications to the request after it is authorized.

Except for measuring controlling field dimensions and locating utilities, do not begin work at the job site until your Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP) is received and approved and the following submittals are received:

1. Notice of Materials to be Used
2. Contingency plan for reopening closures to public traffic

If you obtain approvals for the required submittals, you may begin work on the authorized date. The authorized date is the 1st working day. If you fail to submit a request for authorization to begin work, the first working day will be the 15th day after contract approval.

Complete the work before the earlier of:

1. 25 working days after the 1st working day
2. October 15, 2012.
