Description of Proposed Maintenance Work

Caltrans proposes to install polyvinyl pipe-liners on existing corrugated metal pipes with diameters from 24' to 48' at various locations on State Route 168 (PM 32.5/36.3) in Fresno County east of Prather, in Fresno County. No trees, shrubs or vegetation will be removed. The liner is like a sock that the contractor pulled through the culvert from one end to the other. Then they inflate it to the diameter of the existing culvert and cure it with steam pressure. There's no debris that would fall into the drainage below the culvert.
