Trinidad, the water can be obtained at the Cal-Trans services at FWY 168 and Temperance Ave. The Cal-Trans site supervisor for the irrigation is Ron Richardson if there are any coordination issues. The service belongs to Cal-Trans with Cal-Trans sub-metering to the "hydrant" connection. The City of Clovis supplying the recycled water. The estimated amounts should not pose a supply problem.

Good morning Mr. Rob,

I am currently working on a project on State Route 269 near the City of Huron within the County of Fresno. This project will overlay the existing surface with a thin layer of Asphalt and I am trying to secure a recycled water source for construction. Water needed during construction is about 163,000 gallons (0.5 foot-acre). Most of this quantity will be used for the compaction of asphalt. Average use of 1,000 gallons is anticipated with peak draw of about 4,000 per day for a short period. Construction will be in the summer of 2015.

Please confirm if the City could provide recycled water for construction of this project. If so, then additional information about the water source and quality will be appreciated.
