Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in FRESNO COUNTY IN AND NEAR FRESNO FROM 0.4 km EAST OF CLOVIS AVENUE TO 0.6 km WEST OF COVE ROAD.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on June 7, 2000, instead of the original date of May 31, 2000.

This addendum is being issued to set a new bid opening date as shown herein and revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.04, "Maintain Traffic," Lane Closure Chart No. 2 is revised as attached.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.10, "Seal Coat," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"The maximum length of seal coat operations at any one location, including pilot-car-assisted traffic control, shall be limited to 6.4 kilometers. The minimum space between successive seal coat operations on the lanes in the same direction of travel shall be 6.4 kilometers."

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

R A minimum of one traffic lane, not less than 3.3 m wide, shall be open for use by public traffic.

No lane closure permitted

REMARKS: 1. Close one traffic lane and stop public traffic for a period not to exceed 15 minutes in each direction. If traffic is stopped for longer than 15 minutes, the Contractor shall adjust the length of closure accordingly.  
2. Maximum permitted length of closure is 6.4 km
