This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Notice to Contractors, paragraph seven is replaced as follows:

At the time this contract is awarded, the Contractor shall possess either a Class A license or one of the following Class C licenses: C-13, C-32.

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
