2-1.04 PREBID MEETING

2-1.04A General

A sign-up sheet will be used to identify the attendees.

2-1.04B Mandatory Meeting

The Department will conduct a mandatory prebid meeting for this contract. The purpose of the meeting is to provide small businesses the opportunity to meet and interact with prospective bidders and increase their participation in the performance of contracts.

Each bidder must attend the mandatory prebid meeting. The bidder's representative must be a company officer, project superintendent, or project estimator. For a joint venture, one of the parties must attend the mandatory prebid meeting. The Department does not accept a bid from a bidder who did not attend the meeting.

Each bidder is required to include the name and title of the company representative attending the mandatory prebid meeting. The Department may hold a single prebid meeting for more than 1 contract. Sign the sign-up sheet for the contract you intend to bid on. If you are bidding on multiple contracts, sign each sign-up sheet for each contract you intend to bid on.

The successful bidder is required to report each small business hired to work on this Contract as a result of the mandatory prebid meeting.

2-1.04C Optional Prebid Meeting

Add to section 9-1.16C:

The following items are eligible for progress payment even if they are not incorporated into the work:

1. 18" Slotted Corrugated Steel Pipe (0.064" Thick)

Replace *Reserved* in section 12-3.11B(5) with:

A construction project funding sign must comply with the details shown on the Department's Traffic Operations website.

The sign must be a wood-post sign complying with section 82-3.

The sign panels must be framed, single-sheet aluminum panels complying with section 82-2.

The background on the sign must be Type II retroreflective sheeting. The Type II retroreflective sheeting must be on the Authorized Material List for signing and delineation materials.

The legend must be retroreflective except for nonreflective black letters and numerals. The blue must match PR color no. 3 on FHWA's Color Tolerance Chart. The orange must match PR color no. 6 on FHWA's Color Tolerance Chart.

The legend for the type of project must read as follows:

TYPE OF PROJECT

The legend for the types of funding on a construction project funding sign must read as follows and in the following order:

FEDERAL HIGHWAY TRUST FUNDS

STATE HIGHWAY FUNDS

The Engineer provides the year of completion for the legend on the sign. Install a sign overlay for the year of completion within 15 days of notification.

The legend for the year of completion on a construction project funding sign must read as follows:

YEAR OF COMPLETION 2020

Do not add information to the construction project funding sign unless authorized.

Replace *Reserved* in section 12-3.11C(3) with:

Install 2 Type 2 construction project funding sign at the location determined by the Engineer before starting major work activities visible to highway users.

Dispose of construction project funding signs upon completion of the project if authorized.

Add to the end of section 87-21.03C of the RSS for section 87:

Modifying High mast lighting system includes removing, adjusting, or adding:

1. Foundations
2. Pull boxes
3. Conduit
4. Conductors
5. Standards
6. Luminaires
7. High mast lighting assemblies

Modifying existing electrical systems includes removing high mast luminaire and furnishing, installing and placing into satisfactory operation high mast LED luminaire directly mounted to the high mast standard, complete with all light sources, drivers, wiring inside standard from circuit conductors to high mast luminaire.

Level and secure each high mast LED luminaire in all directions. Adjust any high mast LED luminaires, as directed by the Engineer, to provide optimal illumination distribution.
