Addendum No. 3

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY NEAR WHEATON SPRINGS FROM 2.4 KM SOUTH OF BAILEY ROAD OVERCROSSING TO 1.2 KM NORTH OF YATES WELL ROAD OVERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on October 11, 2007.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.50, "ASPHALT CONCRETE (TYPE C)," the second paragraph is revised as follows:

"The grade of asphalt binder to be mixed with aggregate for asphalt concrete (Type C) shall be PG 64-28 PM."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.50, "ASPHALT CONCRETE (TYPE C)," under the second paragraph, Items A to F are deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.50, "ASPHALT CONCRETE (TYPE C)," the first sentence of the thirty-second paragraph is revised as follows:

"Before placing the pavement reinforcing fabric, a binder of paving asphalt Grade PG 70-10 shall be applied uniformly to the surface to receive the pavement reinforcing fabric at a rate of not less than 1.15 L per square meter of surface covered."

In the Special Provisions, Section 11-1, "QUALITY CONTROL/QUALITY ASSURANCE," subsection 9-2.01, "ASPHALT," the third and fourth paragraphs are revised as follows:

"Asphalt binder for paint binder (tack coat) shall be PG 70-10 conforming to the provisions in "Asphalt Concrete (Type C)" in Section 10-1, "General," of these special provisions.

Asphalt binder for pavement reinforcing fabric shall be PG 70-10 conforming to the provisions in "Asphalt Concrete (Type C)" in Section 10-1, "General," of these special provisions."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 11-1, "QUALITY CONTROL/QUALITY ASSURANCE," subsection 39-2.03, "ASPHALT CONCRETE MIXTURE," Table 39-3 "ASPHALT CONCRETE MIXTURE REQUIREMENTS," is revised as follows:
