OID's standard water truck agreement is attached FYI. OID's canals are a source for non-potable water. Water should be pretty readily available to pull from the OID Burnett Lateral along the north side of SR 120 just west of the intersection with Valley Home Road. I would also consider contacting SSJID as their main canal is crosses SR 120 parallel to west side of Victory Road along the Stanislaus/San Joaquin County line. Their main canal may be more convenient and safer to access for at least some phases of the project.

Our Office Engineer who is reviewing the plan set had the following question regarding the water in the canals:

"For Water Conservation - is the OID canal water potable? Caltrans SSP 17-1.02 requires the use of non-potable water. We need either a statement saying the water is non-potable, or you need to provide a non-potable water source, or you need to provide some evidence of no non-potable water source reasonably available."
