Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY IN AND NEAR TRACY, LATHROP, AND STOCKTON AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON ROUTE 205 FROM 1.2 MILES EAST OF ROUTE 580/205 SEPARATION TO ROUTE 205/5 SEPARATION AND ON ROUTE 5 FROM LOUISE AVENUE UNDERCROSSING TO 1.6 MILES SOUTH OF ROUTE 5/12 SEPARATION.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on October 31, 2007.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," the first paragraph is revised as follows:

"The first working day is the ninetieth day after contract approval."

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," the sixth paragraph is revised as follows:

"The work shall be diligently prosecuted to completion before the expiration of **65 WORKING DAYS.**"

In the Special Provisions, Section 4, "BEGINNING OF WORK, TIME OF COMPLETION, AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES," the seventh paragraph is revised as follows:

"The Contractor shall pay the State of California the sum of \$4500 per day for each day's delay in finishing the work in excess of the number of working days specified above."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-3.09, "MICROWAVE VEHICLE DETECTION SYSTEM – SIDE FIRE," item 8 in the list of the second paragraph is revised as follows:

"8. The vehicle data sample rate shall provide a zone resolution of 2 ft (or smaller) and a time resolution if 10 ms (or shorter)."
