

District Permit No.: T-305-14 **ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The permit shall be signed by **PERMITTEE** on Page 1 and returned to the district office. The permit shall not be valid until the **SIGNED** original permit has been received by the district office.
2. This temporary permit expires upon completion of the event.
3. The temporary Right-of-Way Occupancy Permit, or a conformed copy, shall be kept at the site of the event and must be shown to any representative of the Department of Transportation or any law enforcement officer on demand. **THE EVENT SHALL BE SUSPENDED IF THE PERMIT IS NOT AT THE SITE AS PROVIDED.**
4. The **PERMITTEE**, in addition to obtaining the temporary Right-of-Way Occupancy Permit must also obtain any and all other permits required by State law or local ordinances.
5. The **PERMITTEE** agrees to indemnify and save harmless the State of Nevada and its officers, agents, and employees against any and all liability, loss, damage, cost and expense which it or they may incur, suffer, or be required to pay by reason of death, disease, or bodily injury to any person or persons, or injury to, destruction of, or loss of use of any property, including property belonging to the State of Nevada, arising out of or incident to activities contemplated by this permit, and proximately caused, in whole or in part, by any act or omission of the **PERMITTEE**, or its contractors, agents, or the employees of any one or all of them **OR BY THE OFFICERS, AGENTS, OR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF NEVADA**, unless it is established by the **PERMITTEE** that the proximate cause was the willful misconduct or gross negligence of the officers, agents, or employees of the State of Nevada.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

7. The public Right-of-Way shall be returned to the original condition. Road travel way shall remain clean and free of debris at all times. Removal of trash and debris will be the responsibility of the PERMITTEE.
8. All traffic control shall conform to the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, "Chapter 6," and *The Nevada Department of Transportation Standard Plans for Bridge and Road Construction*, 2010 Edition. **Traffic shall not be delayed more than twenty (20) minutes. Failure to adhere to this condition will result in immediate suspension of activity in the Right-of-Way.**
9. All Category 1 & 2 Traffic Control Devices used on NDOT managed roadways must be National Cooperative Highway Research Program *Report 350* compliant. The PERMITTEE and/or the contractor shall have manufacturer's certificates of compliance available upon request.
10. Traffic control shall be set up as shown on the attached plans, unless otherwise noted herein or directed by a NDOT Permit Inspector. Any deviation from the attached plans will require prior approval from the NDOT District II Permit Office.
11. The work of setting up and tearing down traffic control devices, as required, shall be completed each day, within the hours specified on the permit and/or on the approved traffic control plan. All traffic control devices shall be completely removed from the roadway and sidewalk at the end of the permitted activity period.
12. **PERMITTEE shall be responsible for the maintenance of all signs placed in the NDOT Right of Way.**

And also please take note that I already confirmed this with the Water District Manager about using their facility for our project in Alpine County if the email below is too confusing. As per the Manager, their facility is available for any contractor or agency that is working in Alpine County on State Route 88. They just have to follow the instructions below. This is the closest water agency that can provide water for our projects. As for the non-potable water source, there is a river/stream if the contractor wishes to use non-potable. I confirm this with Field Maintenance and Construction about non-potable water in the area.

Re: Construction Water Supply, Gardnerville Water Company, Gardnerville, Nevada

The Gardnerville Water Company operates a 24/7 construction water fill station located at 1579 Virginia Ranch Road, Gardnerville, Nevada. Construction water can only be taken from this facility within the Gardnerville Water Company District Service area serving the Town of Gardnerville, Nevada. The facility has an overhead fill and a 2 ½ inch fire connection. Contractors who wish to utilize the GWC water fill station must request and fill out an Application for Tanker Water and return the completed form to the Gardnerville Water Company at 1579 Virginia Ranch Road, Gardnerville, Nevada 89410 or fax the completed form to GWC at 775-782-2491. Construction water is billed out on a monthly basis at \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons.
