Addendum No. 2

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY IN STOCKTON FROM 0.5 KM NORTH OF STOCKTON CHANNEL VIADUCT TO MONTE DIABLO AVENUE UNDERCROSSING.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on November 18, 2003.

This addendum is being issued to revise the Project Plans, the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions, and the Proposal and Contract.

Project Plan Sheets 29a, 29b, 29c and 29d are added. Half-sized copies of the added sheets are attached for addition to the project plans.

In the Special Provisions, "IMPORTANT SPECIAL NOTICES," the following paragraphs are added to the end of the Notice:

"Effective September 2, 2003, Triaxial Management Services will no longer provide lists of certified DBEs to contractors bidding on projects or provide DBEs with assistance in preparing bids for subcontracting or supplying materials. Triaxial provided these services for contracts in Districts 01, 02, 03, 04, 05 (except San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties), 06 (except Kern County), 09 and 10.

Contractors bidding on projects in these Districts may obtain lists of certified DBEs from the Department's Website at <http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/bep>. The Department also publishes a quarterly directory of certified firms that may be ordered from the Publications Unit at (916) 445-3520.

Contractors bidding on projects with DBE goals in Districts 05 (San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara Counties), 06 (Kern County), 07, 08, 11 and 12 may continue to call Padilla & Associates at the telephone numbers listed in the Special Provisions."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 2-1.02A, "DBE GOAL FOR THIS PROJECT," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.11, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," the third paragraph is revised as follows:

"At each bridge location, traffic on local streets may be temporarily stopped for periods between 8:00P.M. to 5:00A.M., Sunday through Friday. Buena Vista Avenue and Carlton Avenue shall not be closed simultaneously."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.11, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC," the following paragraph is added after the last paragraph:

"Full compensation for furnishing, maintaining and removing portable construction area signs, as shown on the detour plans, shall be considered as included in the contract lump sum price paid for traffic control system and no additional payment will be made therefor."

In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.155, "BARRICADE," is added as attached.

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In the Special Provisions, Section 10-1.16, "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGN," the following three paragraphs are added after the third paragraph:

"Portable changeable message signs shall be used to inform motorists of the temporary closing of a local street.

The portable changeable message signs shall be installed at least 7 calendar days prior to local street closure, but not more than 14 days in advance.

The portable changeable message signs, when no longer required or when the information becomes outdated, shall be immediately covered or removed, or the sign message shall be updated."

In the Proposal and Contract, the Engineer's Estimate, Item 84 is deleted and Items 85 and 86 are added as attached.

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Replace page 7 of the Engineer's Estimate in the Proposal with the attached revised page 7 of the Engineer's Estimate. The revised Engineer's Estimate is to be used in the bid.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.

This office is sending this addendum by UPS overnight mail to Proposal and Contract book holders to ensure that each receives it. A copy of this addendum and the modified wage rates are available for the contractor's use on the Internet Site:

10-1.155 BARRICADE

Barricades shall be furnished, placed and maintained at the locations shown on the plans, specified in the Standard Specifications or in these special provisions or where designated by the Engineer. Barricades shall conform to the provisions in Section 12, "Construction Area Traffic Control Devices," of the Standard Specifications and these special provisions.

Attention is directed to "Prequalified and Tested Signing and Delineation Materials" of these special provisions regarding retroreflective sheeting for barricades.

Construction area sign and marker panels conforming to the provisions in Section 12-3.06, "Construction Area Signs," of the Standard Specifications shall be installed on barricades in a manner determined by the Engineer at the locations shown on the plans.

Sign panels for construction area signs and marker panels installed on barricades shall conform to the provisions in Section 12-3.06A, "Stationary Mounted Signs," of the Standard Specifications.

Full compensation for furnishing, installing, maintaining, and removing construction area signs and marker panels on barricades shall be considered as included in the contract unit price paid for the type of barricade involved and no separate payment will be made therefor.

Barricades shown on the plans as part of a traffic control system will be paid for as provided in "Traffic Control System for Lane Closure" of these special provisions and will not be included in the count for payment of barricades.
