We have received your request regarding the available water supply from the City of Oceanside Water Utilities to serve the Median Barrier Project from Rancho Del Oro Drive to Melrose Drive. The City of Oceanside currently has adequate potable water supply to meet the estimated total 2,150,000 gallons of water needed for construction of the project. Currently, there is no available reclaimed water in the vicinity of the project.

It is our understanding that construction is anticipated to start January 2015 with an estimated 260 working days. The City reserves the right to uphold the requirements of the drought response levels established by the City Council and implemented based on California's latest drought situation.
