Otay Water District (District) is in receipt of your email dated August 6, 2015 regarding water availability for the Caltrans District 11 Worker Safety Project EA 409601, Project ID 111200004, Construction Contract 11-409604 (Project). As provided to the District, the Project consists of paving beyond the existing gore areas, construction of Maintenance Vehicle Pullout, install gates, relocate traffic cabinet, and pave existing dirt median on State Route 54 (Jamacha Road) between Calle Albara Road and Jamacha Way in El Cajon, San Diego County.

The District has no objections with providing water for construction purposes for the above mentioned Project. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and/or the Construction Contractor working on behalf of Caltrans will be responsible for all costs associated with obtaining temporary construction meter(s) and water usage during construction. The temporary construction meter(s) applications (**TEMPORARY WATER METERS (FOR USE ON HYDRANT)**) can be obtained from the District's web page at http://www.otaywater.gov/engineering/public_services.

Water availability is subject to all District requirements in effect at the time of application. You are strongly encouraged to adopt water conservation measures throughout the development. In response to Governor Brown's declaration of a statewide drought, calling on all Californians to save water, the District has adopted Ordinance No. 551 on June 3, 2015 declaring a State Drought Emergency and calling for mandatory conservation to attain the State established target for the Otay Water District to reduce total potable water use by 20 percent of 2013 levels.

Sweetwater Authority (Authority) is in receipt of your email dated December 17, 2015 regarding water availability for the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 11 Worker Safety Project EA 409601, Project ID 1112000048, Contract 11-409604 (Project). As provided to the Authority, the Project consists of paving beyond existing gore areas, construction of a maintenance vehicle pullout, installation of gates, relocation of traffic cabinets, and median pavement on State Route 54.

Water is available at the proposed project sites within the Authority's service area, and the Authority may provide potable water for construction purposes, subject to Authority Rates, Rules, Policies, and Procedures, for the above referenced project. Caltrans or its Contractor(s) shall be responsible for all costs associated with obtaining temporary construction meter(s) and water usage during construction. Temporary construction meter applications can be obtained at the Authority's Administration Office located at 505 Garrett Avenue, Chula Vista, CA, 91910.

Water availability is subject to all Authority requirements in effect at the time of application. Caltrans is strongly encouraged to adopt water conservation measures throughout development. In September 2014, the Authority's Governing Board activated Level 2 of its Drought Response Plan. On June 24, 2015, the Governing Board amended its Drought Response Plan to include additional conservation measures that are aligned with Governor Brown's state-wide mandate to reduce water use.
