Addendum No. 1

Dear Contractor:

This addendum is being issued to the contract for construction on State highway in ORANGE COUNTY NEAR SAN JUAN HOT SPRINGS FROM SAN JUAN CANYON BRIDGE TO RIVERSIDE COUNTY LINE.

Submit bids for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this addendum. The revisions declared in this addendum are an essential part of the contract.

Bids for this work will be opened on December 14, 2006, instead of the original date of November 30, 2006.

This addendum is being issued to set a new bid opening date as shown herein and revise the Project Plans, the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions, and the Federal Minimum Wages with Modification Number 34 dated 11-03-06.

Project Plan Sheets 185, 186, and 187 are revised. Half-sized copies of the revised sheets are attached for substitution for the like-numbered sheets.

In the Special Provisions, Section 1-1.17, "MAINTAINING TRAFFIC", the fifth paragraph is deleted.

In the Special Provisions, Section 1-1.32, "BLASTING", in subsection "ROCK SCULPTING", the first paragraph is revised as follows:

"Rock sculpting shall be constructed in conformance with the lines and grades shown on the plans or as directed by the Engineer. When completed, the average plane of the slopes shall conform to the slope indicated in the plans and no point on the slope shall vary from the designated slopes by more than one meter, measured at right angles to the slope. In no case shall any portion of the slope encroach on the roadbed."

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In the Special Provisions, Section 1-1.38, "TRANSPLANT NATIVE PLANTS", the eighth paragraph is revised as follows:

"Native plants to be transplanted shall be maintained from the time the native plants are removed to the time of acceptance of the contract, provided however, that the contract will not be accepted unless the native plants have been satisfactorily maintained for at least 120 working days after transplanting has been completed. The native plants shall be watered and fertilized as necessary to maintain the native plants in a healthy condition. Trash, debris and weeds within basins, including the basin walls, shall be removed and disposed of in conformance with the provisions in Section 7-1.13, "Disposal of Material Outside the Highway Right of Way," of the Standard Specifications. Weeds shall be removed by hand pulling before the weeds exceed 50 mm in length. Pesticides shall not be used."

To Proposal and Contract book holders:

Inquiries or questions in regard to this addendum must be communicated as a bidder inquiry and must be made as noted in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS section of the Notice to Contractors and Special Provisions.

Indicate receipt of this addendum by filling in the number of this addendum in the space provided on the signature page of the proposal.

Submit bids in the Proposal and Contract book you now possess. Holders who have already mailed their book will be contacted to arrange for the return of their book.

Inform subcontractors and suppliers as necessary.
