Completes various repair records and reports, uses computer equipment to input time spent on tasks performed. Employee may assist in the instruction or giving of direction to helpers, apprentices, or other employees. Employee is responsible for reasonable safeguards, proper use and handling of materials, equipment, & facilities. May need to work outside and/or travel to assist at other field mechanic's location or other highway maintenance stations. Employee must be able to work in these areas in inclement weather, including severe cold or heat. May be subject to travel, rotation, and position is subject to changes of shift, work hours and workdays, and mandatory overtime.
