Inspects work as to the quality, quantity, and methodology. Records manpower and equipment usage along with pertinent details and prepares documentation of the work performed. Performs laboratory physical tests of highway construction and other materials, including collecting data and sampling construction materials in coordination with the Contractor's personnel.
