

Subject: **STEWARDSHIP AGREEMENT TRANSMITTAL**

Attached is the Design Stewardship Agreement between District 4 and the Division of Design (DOD), which was executed and effective January 30, 2015. This agreement documents the delegation of approval authority to the District Director for application of certain standards and policies previously held by DOD, and supplements prior delegations, including those prescribed in my June 7, 2013 Memorandum, "Division of Design Policy Updates", to the District Directors.

This is a very significant step as the Department increases delegated authority to the Districts to streamline decision-making. The Department, as owner/operator of the State Highway System, maintains the statutory and inherent obligation to ensure that all modifications or additions to the State Highway System provide a safe, sustainable, integrated, and efficient transportation system. This stewardship agreement establishes a framework for DOD and the District to uphold these expectations and maintain the accountability of the department's agents, leaders, and staff, for carrying out these responsibilities.

Thanks to you and your staff for taking this huge step forward. DOD is committed to the continued support of the districts to facilitate the delivery of quality projects to enhance California's economy and livability.
