




Cinnamon Drive Canal Planning Study

Project Summary:

Lemoore citizens must walk along Cinnamon Drive between an open canal and a street with a 35 MPH speed limit. Also they often jump the canal in order to access the City Recreation Center. The project will complete the needed planning to relocate underground approximately 1200 feet of open canal in order to construct curbs, gutters, sidewalks, a bike lane and pedestrian entry to the Recreation Center.

Community Outreach

- The three preliminary designs of the proposed sidewalks and recreation center entrances were presented to the public in two small group meetings both taking place on November 8th 2012 one in the morning and the other in the evening.
- Following the presentation of the preliminary design alternatives the attendees were asked to vote for designs that they liked best.
- 39 people had signed in as a total for both meetings however they did not identify which meeting they had attended.

Project Outcome

- Option “C” was unanimously decided upon those whom attended the meeting and so the office began consulting with the city of Lemoore to determine a final concept design

Successes & Next Steps

- Option “C” was unanimously decided upon by the people of Lemoore
- The City of Lemoore is planning to use State Regional Improvement Program and local funds in order to make the aforementioned improvements to the canal and the recreation center.
