- Links MIS/Corridor Study outreach to other planning efforts along SR-12, including coordination with SR-12 CSMP in Napa/Solano
- Phase I: Public Engagement Plan (PEP)
- Phase II: Implementation of PEP & updated SR-12 MIS/Corridor Study
