Overview

This memo has been prepared to document the tribal and stakeholder outreach activities associated with the development of the SR 49 TCR. This documentation has been prepared to supplement the materials provided in the Public Outreach Summary Report. Attached to this memo are the following supporting documents:

Tribal Outreach

MIG was provided with an initial tribal contact list by Kathleen McClafflin on November 23, 2009, and instructed to send meeting invitations for Project Development Team meetings via US Mail to Federally Recognized tribes in each of the four Counties in the SR 49 TCR corridor, and to conduct follow-up phone calls. Letters were sent to tribal representatives in advance of most of the Project Development Team Meetings and Public Workshops, and follow-up calls were conducted. Due to administrative oversight, letters were not sent and calls were not made in advance of every meeting. **Table 1: Meeting Letter and Call Summary**, on the following page, identifies each meeting and whether a letter was sent or a call was made.

Letters for the Amador PDT Meeting 1 (12/8/09) and the Calaveras PDT Meeting 1 (12/17/09) were merged as one letter and sent to tribal representatives from both areas.

As noted in Table 1, a telephone call was made and an email was sent to Tony Brochini, Chairman, Southern Sierra Miwuk Nation, to invite him to the November 18, 2009, Mariposa PDT meeting

(communication attached). The project team had not formalized the letter content and format for tribal communications at the time of the November Mariposa meeting; so MIG called and emailed Mr. Brochini to notify him of the meeting.

Please note that the attached tribal roster reflects the final tribal roster used at the conclusion of the project. Over the course of the project, the initial roster was updated based on input from calls to tribes. Therefore, the final roster and the sent letters do not match exactly. For example, Bob Terry, Ione Band of Miwok Indians is on the Tuolumne County Roster but was not sent a letter for the Tuolumne January 14th Development Team Meeting as he had not yet been identified as a tribal contact.

The updates to the original roster based on meeting invitation calls and tribal website research are detailed below in **Table 2: Tribal Roster Updates**.

The following list below provides clarification regarding discrepancies between the final tribal roster and the letters sent:

December 1, 2009

- The Honorable Rhonda Morningstar Pope, Chairwoman of Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians, is listed on the Amador County mailing list with cc's: Pati Gonsalves and Roselyn Lwenya. The instruction to add individuals to be copied on this letter was provided later in the process.
- Gil Jameson, Acting Chair, Ione Band of Miwok Indians appears on the roster but was not sent a letter for the Amador December 8th Development Team Meeting. Mr. Jameson replaced Nicolas Villa, Jr., who was still Chief of the Ione Band of Miwok Indians at the time and was sent a letter.

January 6, 2010

- Bob Terry, Ione Band of Miwok Indians is on the Tuolumne County mailing list but was not sent a letter for the Tuolumne January 14th Development Team Meeting. He was identified as a contact later in the process based on follow-up calls made.

August 2, 2010

- The Honorable Rhonda Morningstar Pope, Chairwoman of Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians, is listed on the Amador County mailing list with cc: Pati Gonsalves and cc: Roselyn Lwenya. Roselyn Lwenya did not receive a copy of the letter, as her contact information was not received until later in the process, based on follow-up calls made.
- Pati Gonsalves, Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians received a letter with no salutation due to administrative oversight.

October 14, 2010

- The Honorable Rhonda Morningstar Pope, Chairwoman of Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians, is listed on the Amador County mailing list with cc: Pati Gonsalves and cc: Roselyn Lwenya. The contact information for Roselyn Lwenya was not added to the roster until later in the process, based on follow-up calls.
- Pati Gonsalves, Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians received a letter. The letter was addressed to The Honorable Rhonda Morningstar Pope, with Ms. Gonsalves listed as to be copied.

Stakeholder Outreach

For the list of project stakeholders, MIG focused efforts on including those stakeholders in Project Development Team meetings. Because of the long-range nature of the planning effort, the project team considered this effort to be adequate to satisfy Title VI requirements. Caltrans planner Maria Rodriguez visited local businesses along the corridor to distribute workshop flyers in advance of upcoming community workshops.
