6.1	134	Although not required by law, MPOs should identify a set of indicators that will be used to assess the performance of the RTP, including, but not limited to, all of the following: Add "Measures of impact on public health"
Appendix I	276	Transportation Planning and Investment Strategies Add: 7. In setting priorities, consider transportation projects that provide public health co-benefits.
