## RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the following 2010 SHOPP Amendments be approved:

### **2010 SHOPP AMENDMENTS TO ALLOW FUNDING IN FY 2010/11 AND BEYOND**

This amendment adds an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Curb Ramps project on routes 1, 101, and 135 in Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo counties at a total cost of \$1,842,000 (\$702,000 Right of Way and \$1,140,000 Construction). This project is necessary to install and/or upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to meet ADA standards. This project will be funded from the ADA New Curb Ramps Reservation in the 2010 SHOPP.

This project is necessary to rehabilitate the parking and ramp paving to these SRRAs. This project will be funded from the programming capacity provided through the updated 2010 SHOPP Fund Estimate approved April 2010.
