TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF (TCR) PROGRAM
DEPARTMENT ALLOCATIONS REPORT
PER RESOLUTION G-00-23

Government Code (GC) Section 14556.5(a) authorizes the Department of Transportation (Department) to allocate funds from the Traffic Congestion Relief (TCR) Fund, as directed by the California Transportation Commission (Commission), for specific projects, or phases of a project, listed under GC Section 14556.40.

Since the December 5-6, 2000 Commission meeting, the Department has allocated TCR funds totaling \$37,555,000 for nine projects, or phases of a project, programmed in the Traffic Congestion Relief Program. The project applications corresponding to these allocations were approved through previous Commission action.
