ROUTE 80 IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY

RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-01-16.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:



- Route 80 in Sacramento County– Modify the Madison Avenue Interchange in the communities of North Highlands and Foothill Farms.

The project is programmed in the 2000 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for construction in the 2001/02. The STIP includes \$4.5 million (capital funds) towards a total project cost of \$10.6 million. Sacramento County will contribute \$6.1 million from Measure A. The current estimate for the project is \$10.6 million.

The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The County of Sacramento has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

Resolution E-01-15

- 1.1 **WHEREAS**, the County of Sacramento has completed a Negative Declaration in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the CEQA Guidelines, and the California Transportation Commission Environmental Regulations for the following project:
 - Route 80 in Sacramento County– Modify the Madison Avenue Interchange in the communities of North Highlands and Foothill Farms.
- 1.2 **WHEREAS**, the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, has considered the information contained in the Negative Declaration; and
