RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolution R-3478 - R-3479.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3478 – 3-Sut-99-KP 20.5/29.1 (Request No. 32959-X) – 6 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Sutter, between Sacramento Avenue and Central Avenue, consisting of county road connections. Project completed on September 25, 2000. The County by letter dated October 25, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3479 – 11-SD-905-PM 12.0 (Request No. 27226) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of San Diego, being portions of Via De La Amistad Drive, Siempre Viva Road and Enrico Fermi Drive, consisting of reconstructed county roads. Project completed on June 15, 2000. The County by cooperative agreement dated November 3, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by amendment to agreement dated December 22, 2000, extended the termination date of the cooperative agreement.

RELINQUISHMENT OF HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY IN THE
COUNTY OF SUTTER, ROAD 3-SUT-99-KP 20.5/29.1
Request No. 32959-X

WHEREAS, by letter dated October 25, 2000, the County of Sutter waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title to county road connections, upon relinquishment thereof to said County by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has acquired right of way for and has constructed the above-mentioned collateral facilities in the County of Sutter, between Sacramento Avenue and Central Avenue, road 3-Sut-99; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that said collateral facilities be relinquished to the County of Sutter for use as county highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Transportation Commission that it relinquish, and it does hereby relinquish, to the County of Sutter, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of Sutter County, all of the State of California's right, title and interest in and to said collateral facilities in said County, together with the right of way and appurtenances thereof, described as follows:

All that portion of reconstructed county roads as indicated by outlining and designated as SEGMENTS 1 through 6 as shown on those certain highway maps filed January 22, 2001, in State Highway Map Book No. 2 at pages 33 through 38, inclusive, Records of Sutter County.

RELINQUISHMENT OF HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY IN THE
COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, ROAD 11-SD-905-PM 12.0
Request No. 27226

WHEREAS, by cooperative agreement dated November 3, 2000, between the County of San Diego and the State of California, the County waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title to reconstructed county roads, upon relinquishment thereof to said County by the State of California and by amendment to agreement dated December 22, 2000, the county extended the expiration date of the cooperative agreement; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has acquired right of way for and has constructed the above-mentioned collateral facilities in the County of San Diego, being portions of Via De La Amistad Drive, Siempre Viva Road and Enrico Fermi Drive, road 11-SD-905, in accordance with said agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that said collateral facilities be relinquished to the County of San Diego for use as county highways;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Transportation Commission that it relinquish, and it does hereby relinquish, to the County of San Diego, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of San Diego County, all of the State of California's right,

title and interest in and to said collateral facilities in said County, together with the right of way and appurtenances thereof, described as follows:

All that portion of reconstructed and re-aligned county road, together with all appurtenant facilities contiguous and adjacent thereto, designated as "Relinquishment No. R27226", SEGMENTS 1 and 2, on those certain relinquishment maps filed as, sheets 1 and 2, as State Highway Map No. 306 File Page 2001-0025606, dated January 17, 2001 filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County.
