RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$3,841,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2000, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for four (3) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$3,841,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for four (4) local RIP projects listed in the 1998 STIP at an estimated cost of \$4,919,000, including \$1,078,000 from other sources.
