**INFORMATIONAL REPORT ON DELEGATED ALLOCATIONS FOR  
TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF (TCR) PROGRAM PROJECTS**

Government Code (GC) Section 14556.5(a) authorizes the Department of Transportation (Department) to allocate funds from the Traffic Congestion Relief (TCR) Fund, as directed by the California Transportation Commission (Commission), for specific projects, or phases of a project, listed under GC Section 14556.40.

Since the January 17-18, 2001 Commission meeting, the Department has allocated TCR funds totaling \$43,637,000 for eight projects, or phases of a project, programmed in the TCR Program. Through the end of January 2001, a total of \$626,231,000 in project applications has been approved, with \$339,609,000 allocated.

The project applications corresponding to these allocations were approved through previous Commission action.
