BACKGROUND


This amendment programs \$870,000 from Sierra County's Unprogrammed Share Balance for a roadway rehabilitation project near Loyalton.

Heriot Lane consists primarily as a gravel road with farm and ranch lands on each side. Portions of the road are paved, but in need of rehabilitation. This project will place asphalt concrete pavement on the gravel portion of Heriot Lane, overlay the existing paved portion near State Route 49, and replace fencing for the length of the project.
