DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY
LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR RSTP/CMAQ MATCH RESERVE PROJECTS
RESOLUTION G-01-05 ALLOCATIONS

BACKGROUND

On February 22, 2001, the California Transportation Commission delegated to the Department authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-01-05 for RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects programmed in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). In addition, the Commission delegated to the Department authority to advance the allocation by two years with the approval of the responsible regional agency. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next CTC meeting to receive an allocation.

These RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects are included in the adopted STIP. The Department reports allocations on a monthly basis consistent with Resolution G-01-05.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-01-05, since the last report the Department made 10 separate allocations totaling \$115,000, for 10 RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects. A list of the allocations is attached. No advance allocations were made.
