APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING
ROUTE 80 IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY

RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-00-21.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Route 80 in Sacramento County- Modify the Greenback Lane/Elkhorn Boulevard Interchange in the community of North Highlands and city of Citrus Heights.

The project is programmed in the 1998 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for construction in the 1999/2000 fiscal year at \$15.2 million (\$4.9 million STIP funds and \$10.3 million local funds). STIP funds are shown as \$3.7 million capital funds and \$1.2 million support funds. The current estimate for the project is \$11.6 million (\$4.9 million STIP funds and \$6.7 local funds). The current estimate includes capital and support costs.

The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.
