RESOLUTION FP-99-92

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$2,107,233 be allocated from the Budget Act OF 1999, Item 2660-101-0183 for nine (9) Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation (EEM) projects.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates a total of \$2,107,233 in State funds for nine (9) EEM projects included in the approved project list at an estimated cost of \$3,826,367, including \$1,719,134 from other sources.

The statute mandates the Resources Agency to evaluate proposals and the CTC to award grants to fund proposals recommended by the Resource Agency. The 1999 EEM Program was adopted at the July 14-15, 1999 CTC meeting.
