**APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING**  
**ROUTE 101 IN MARIN COUNTY**

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which an Environmental Impact Report has been completed:

- Route 101 in Marin County- Construct a High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane between Lucky Drive in the City of Corte Madera and North San Pedro Road in the City of San Rafael.

The current estimate for the project is \$117.2 million. The project is fully funded from the 2000 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), the Governor's Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP), and locally controlled Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds. At the May CTC meeting, the Project was noticed for a STIP Amendment to combine the Southbound HOV Lane Project with the Reversible HOV project for a fully funded project for the ultimate HOV configuration. The TCRP and CMAQ funds added to the project since adoption of the 2000 STIP provided the opportunity for construction of the ultimate facility.


The Environmental Impact Report has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-01-22.
