**APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING**  
**ROUTE 60 IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY**

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Route 60 in Los Angeles County- Construct a High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) connector to Route 57 and a collector road in the City of Industry.

The project is programmed in the 2000 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for \$78.3 million (\$67.1 million capital funds and \$11.2 million support funds). The current cost estimate for the project is \$78.3 million (capital and support costs).

The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-01-30.

# State Route 57 & 60 Weave Improvement Project



**Resolution E-01-30**
