The following 7 agenda items are information reports and are deemed by staff not to raise any issue. The reports are included in the Commission Meeting Book mailed to each Commissioner for examination. **These items will not be presented or discussed at the meeting unless specifically requested by a Commissioner.**

2.1b. STIP Amendments for Notice

2.1b.(1) Amend the STIP to transfer \$600,000 from the Solano County Route 37 new 4-lane freeway construction project to the environmental mitigation project.

2.1b.(2) Amend the STIP to change the scope of the \$160,000 TEA Feather River Bikeway project from construction to project development.

2.5f. Information Reports on Allocations made by Caltrans Under Commission Delegated Authority

2.5f.(1) Six emergency condition project allocations totaling \$3,030,000.

2.5f.(2) Twenty-three SHOPP pavement rehabilitation project allocations totaling \$68,844,000.

2.5f.(3) One SHOPP safety allocation totaling \$1,928,000.

2.5f.(4) Forty-one local storm damage and pavement rehabilitation allocations totaling \$11,897,000.

3.2 Monthly Report on Caltrans projects voted but not awarded

The Department's last report had two projects on the voted but not awarded list. Since the last report the Department rescinded the allocation for one project and add two new projects to the list.

Remaining project from last report:

- Richmond-San Rafael Toll Bridge – seismic retrofit \$323,518,000 - bid opening has been suspended while the Department federalizes the project. The Commission approved an extension to award the project until the end of November 2000. The Department has scheduled bid opening for August 8, 2000.

New projects added to report:

- Plu-L5727 mechanics facility, storage building and office space at the Quincy Maintenance Station in Plumas County \$2,740,000 – bids were opened in February 2000 and rejected. The Commission approved supplemental funding at the May 2000 meeting. The Department scheduled readvertisement for August 2000.
- Ker-178 resurface roadway, in Kern County \$1,778,000 – coordination with other projects and construction window preclud start of work until after September 15, 2000. Bid opening is scheduled for July 25, 2000.
