BACKGROUND

This amendment programs \$2,530,000 from Monterey County's Unprogrammed Share Balance in FY 2001-02 for a rehabilitation project on Blanco Road in Monterey County.


The Monterey County Department of Public Works recently conducted a pavement analysis study of all County unincorporated roadways. The study indicated that Blanco Road is in need of immediate rehabilitation. The proposed rehabilitation project involves the excavation and replacement of failed areas, asphalt concrete overlay, shoulder restoration and pavement marking replacement.

During adoption of the 2000 STIP, Monterey County earmarked \$4,322,000 from its unprogrammed share balance as a reserve for later STIP amendments to program local road rehabilitation and public transit projects. The Blanco Road Rehabilitation and Overlay project is being funded from this reserve.
