Ref: South Bay Maintenance Facility Expansion Project (San Diego County) – Consideration of Future Funding for the Expansion of a Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) Fueling Station (Notice of Determination) (TCRP #75) Resolution E-02-3

Issue:

Should the Commission adopt the attached resolution to approve future consideration of funding for the expansion of the South Bay Maintenance Facility by the San Diego Metropolitan Transit Development Board?

Recommendation:

Commission staff recommends that the Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-02-3.

Background:

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration under the California Environmental Quality Act has been completed:

- South Bay Maintenance Facility Expansion Project (San Diego County) – Expansion of CNG fueling station

The current estimate for the project is \$800,000 in which TCRP funds will fully fund the project. The project is included in San Diego Metropolitan Transit Development Board's TCRP application, as part of Project #75, which the Commission will consider for approval at its July 11-12, 2001.

The San Diego Metropolitan Transit Development Board has approved a Negative Declaration for the expansion of the South Bay Maintenance Facility. The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff. The Commission's approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.
