**ALLOCATIONS FOR LOCAL ASSISTANCE
TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT ACTIVITIES (TEA) PROJECTS**

RESOLUTION FP-01-06

RECOMMENDATION

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$992,000 in Federal TEA funds be allocated from the 2001 Budget Act, Item 2660-101-0890 for one (1) local assistance TEA project.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This Resolution allocates \$992,000 in Federal funds from 2001 Budget Act Item 2660-101-0890 for one (1) local TEA project from the approved list.

This month's vote includes one (1) new local TEA project at an estimated cost of \$1,112,000, including \$120,000 from other sources.

The Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 requires that at least 10 percent of all Surface Transportation Program expenditures in each state be used for defined Transportation Enhancement Activities (TEA).

The Commission adopted guidelines for the TEA program through Resolution #G-93-3 in February 1993 (as amended June 7, 1995), and adopted the Initial Federal TEA Program through Resolution #G-93-12 in August 1993. The Commission adopted the second round of Federal TEA projects in the 1994 STIP in March

1994. The third round of Federal TEA projects was adopted into the 1996 STIP by Commission Resolution #G-96-21.
