### RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS OF NECESSITY

We recommend Rescinding Resolutions of Necessity be adopted by the Commission. In accordance with statutory requirements, the owner has been advised that the Department of Transportation is requesting rescission of the Resolution at this time. A rescission is necessary as a condition of agreement to a Right of Entry from the owner to construct the State's project.

#### CR-125 - Contra Costa County Flood Control & Water Conservation District.

04-CC-680-PM 20.9-Parcel 58059-1A,1B,1C,1D,1E (Freeway) Authorizes condemnation of an easement for batter pile purposes, an easement for drainage purposes, a temporary easement for construction purposes, two temporary easements for access purposes, located in the unincorporated area of Contra Costa County at Grayson Creek. Resolution C-18586 is rescinded as a condition of agreement to a Right of Entry from the owner to construct the State's project.

#### CR-126 - Contra Costa County Flood Control & Water Conservation District.

04-CC-680-PM 20.9-Parcel 58368-1A,1B,1C,1D,1E,1F (Freeway) Authorizes condemnation of land in fee for a State highway, extinguishment of abutter's rights of access, four temporary easements for construction and access, a permanent easement for drainage, located near the unincorporated area of Contra Costa County at Grayson Creek. Resolution C-18587 is rescinded as a condition of agreement to a Right of Entry from the owner to construct the State's project.
