The following 9 agenda items are information reports and are deemed by staff not to raise any issue. The reports are included in the Commission Meeting Book mailed to each Commissioner for examination. **These items will not be presented or discussed at the meeting unless specifically requested by a Commissioner.**

2.5f. Information Reports on Allocations made by Caltrans Under CTC Delegated Authority

- 2.5f.(1)** Three emergency condition allocations totaling \$970,000.
- 2.5f.(2)** Seven SHOPP pavement rehabilitation allocations totaling \$53,892,000.
- 2.5f.(3)** Three SHOPP safety allocations totaling \$6,074,000.
- 2.5f.(4)** Thirty-five local storm damage and pavement rehabilitation allocations totaling \$12,687,000.
- 2.5f.(5)** Twenty-four local project development allocations totaling \$3,918,000.
- 2.5f.(6)** Five local rideshare allocations totaling \$5,796,000.
- 2.5f.(7)** Fifty-five RSTP/CMAQ match allocations totaling \$1,885,000.
- 2.5f.(8)** Twenty-three local planning, programming and monitoring allocations totaling \$5,115,000.

3.2 Monthly Report on Caltrans projects voted but not awarded

The Department's last report had three projects on the voted but not awarded list. Since the last report the Department did not awarded any projects and did not add any new projects to the list.

Remaining projects from last report:

- Richmond-San Rafael Toll Bridge – seismic retrofit \$323,518,000 - bid opening was suspended while the Department federalizes the project. The Commission approved an extension to award the project until the end of November 2000. The Department opened bids for this project on August 8, 2000 and will report outcome of award at the September Commission meeting.
- Plu-L5727 mechanics facility, storage building and office space at the Quincy Maintenance Station in Plumas County \$2,740,000 – bids were opened in February 2000 and rejected. The Commission approved supplemental funding at the May 2000 meeting. The Department scheduled re-advertisement for August 2000 with bid opening in October 2000.
- Ker-178 resurface roadway, in Kern County \$1,778,000 – coordination with other projects and construction window preclude start of work until after September 15, 2000. Bid opening is now scheduled for August 9, 2000.
