APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING
ROUTE 101 IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-01-5.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Route 101 in Los Angeles County- Reconstruct the Vignes Street ramps in downtown Los Angeles.

The project is programmed in the 1998 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for construction in the 2003/04 fiscal year at \$17.2 million (\$15.1 million capital funds and \$2.1 million support funds). The \$15.1 million in capital funds are shown as \$13.6 million STIP funds and \$1.5 million local funds. The current cost estimate for the project is \$15.1 million (capital and support cost).

The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.
