RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$3,600,000 be allocated from Budget Act Items 2660-301-0042 and 2660-301-0890, Budget Act of 2000, for the project on the attached list.

The Department has complied with the National Environmental Policy Act and the California Environmental Quality Act requirements in preparing these projects.

This major construction projects proposed for funding is included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates State and Federal funds totaling \$3,600,000 for one (1) major STIP construction project. The total cost of new major STIP construction project is estimated at \$3,600,000.
