**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR PROJECT DEVELOPMENT COMPONENTS**  
**OF LOCAL GRANT PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-99-22 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On July 15, 1999, the California Transportation Commission delegated to the Department authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-99-22 for Project Development Components of Local Grant projects. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next CTC meeting to receive an allocation.

These Project Development Cost projects are included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Department reports allocations on a quarterly basis consistent with Resolution G-99-22.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-99-22, since the last report the Department made 25 separate allocations of State and Federal Funds totaling \$3,918,000, for 24 Project Development Components of Local Grant projects. Twenty-four allocations, totaling \$3,904,000, were made in Fiscal Year (FY) 99-00. One allocation, totaling \$14,000, was made in FY 00-01. A list of the allocations is attached.

Since the last report, two projects were identified with captured savings of \$253,000. The project information for captured savings is shown in Attachments I and II.
